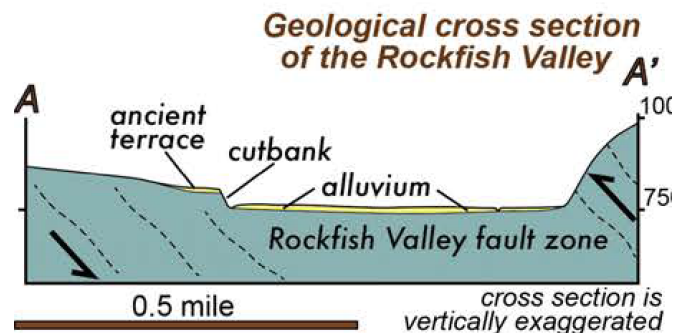

Steve is the author of the 2017 book Plein Air Painting which will be available for purchase and autograph. He was editor of Plein Air magazine for decades. Anthony was the youngest painter at the event and the seller of the most paintings. He will speak on how getting outdoors inspires him and how gratitude fuels him to keep learning and practicing.
