

EnLit - ENVIRONMENTAL LITERACY PROJECT INFRASTRUCTURE STATUS IS:




- Activated: Wireless network along the Spruce Creek Park trails and Rockfish Valley Trail downstream of Camille Trailhead.

- Installed: QR codes along both trail systems to connect to cell phones and devices.
- Completed: RVF website section to host ENLIT modules and content management.
- Underway: Content outreach to state agencies, educators and non-profits including VA Master Naturalists, VA DOF, Blue Ridge Prism and VA DWR.
